2010-2011 CONNACHT MASTERS' SQUASH REPORT

The 2010 CONNACHT MASTERS' SQUASH OPEN tournament was scheduled for the weekend of 3rd - 4th December 2010, a week later than in previous years. However this coincided with the first of the winter blizzards and the tournament had to be postponed due to the inability of players to travel. While this decision received unanimous support from Irish-based players, some overseas players who had already made travel arrangements voiced disapproval. The postponement was a great disappointment to the organisers, as the entry was the largest ever such that they were having difficulties scheduling all the matches! The tournament was re-scheduled for the weekend of 25th – 26th March 2011, with Jim Hynes as Tournament Director, assisted by Michael Hynes.

A total of 45 competitors eventually arrived and competed in the various sections. The ladies' section attracted seven entries, a significant increase on the previous year. There were eight entries in the O-45 age group. The O-50 attracted eleven players, with eight in Section A and three in Section B. There were eight entries in the O-55 section. Three entrants arrived to play in the O-60 section. Eight competitors arrived to play in the O-65 section. As usual, the entry included many of the top-ranked Irish players. The overall standard of play was excellent, with some wonderful, closely-fought matches. The social aspect of the tournament was greatly enhanced by the provision of food on Friday evening, as it meant that players stayed around the club. The tournament dinner was held in the club on Saturday night.

The final of the O-45 was contested by Eddie Murphy and Neil Stone-Wigg, with Stone-Wigg prevailing on a score of 3/2 in an extremely close match. This ensures that yet another new name is added to the plaque on the Michael Devaney Trophy, which is awarded to the winner of the O-45A section. Damien O'Reilly and Peter Cassidy set out to compete in the O-50 final. This was an enthralling encounter until Peter Cassidy was forced to retire through injury to leave Damien O'Reilly the winner. Local man Dave Lalor won all his matches to take the O-50B award. The O-55 final was a closely fought match between Martin McDonnell and Frank Donnelly, with the former winning on a score of 3/1. The O-60 section was unusual in that each player won one match and lost one match. However on both games won and lost and points won and lost, John KIELTY was the winner. In the O-65 final, Ciarán Roche beat Frank Fahey to take his first ever Irish Squash title.

Local player Norrie O'Grady kept a clean sheet by overcoming Ann Gray (3/0) to take the Ladies' title.

During the Tournament Dinner, Jim Hynes was honoured with the '2010-2011 Squash Person of the Year Award' for his outstanding contributions to squash over the years.

COACHING: -

Edwin Brennan assumed the role of club coach in Galway LTC this season after Paul Bell returned to the UK early in the season. As well as coaching the junior players of Galway LTC, Edwin offered squash in the local schools, thanks to important funding from Irish Squash and the Irish Sport Council, which was very popular with over 500 kids trying squash over the season. The development programme is working very well and with added funding it could have a great impact on squash in the province for years to come. Helen Reapy also continued her fantastic work in Claremorris squash club. With only 1 court space is always limited however the number of players is increasing and the standard is improving all the time.

A level 1 coaching course was held in Galway LTC this season and 11 newly qualified coaches emerged from the course.
